What Would Jesus Drive?

Is the vehicle you choose to drive a moral choice? That's the question the What Would Jesus Drive campaign poses to America. This discussion was initiated by the Evangelical Environmental Network and by Creation Care Magazine.

This quote from the WWJD web site says it best.

The question, "What Would Jesus Drive?" is a more specific version of the well-known question, "What Would Jesus Do?" Christians ask themselves "What Would Jesus Do?" to help guide them in their daily decisions as disciples (or followers) of Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns in their hearts. As followers, the question actually becomes, "Lord, what would you have me do?" So our specific question then becomes, "Lord, what would you have me drive?"

To further raise awareness the campaign is conducting a tour of the southeast. The tour begins in Austin, Texas on May 28 and concludes in Washington, D.C. on July 7th. EEN director and campaign chairman Rev. Jim Ball is stopping along the way to publicize the event and conduct meetings with local officials and with local congregations.

The WWJD tour will be in Chattanooga on Monday, June 9th. Rev. Ball will be interviewed on WPWT Christian Talk Radio, 870 AM, 7:30-8:00 a.m..
